

## Information on your pet's overnight stay at Park Vets

We're sorry to hear that your pet needs an overnight stay at Park Vets and hope that they get better soon.

Be reassured that your pet will be extremely well looked after whilst in the care of Park Vets.

We always have a dedicated overnight Registered Veterinary Nurse on site looking after your pet throughout the night. The nurse will monitor your pet overnight, doing regular checks, administering any medication prescribed by the vet in charge of your pet's case, walking them, keeping their bed clean and comfy and of course giving them lots of love and attention.

Hospital rounds are done as a minimum every 4 hours, but can be almost continuous if your pet requires intensive nursing. The vet in charge will have given the nurse guidance as to the severity of illness and hence frequency of checks.

If the nurse has any concerns during her night duty, she has direct access to a vet on call to discuss the case and ask for assistance.

Our overnight nurse will inform you of your pet's progress at approximately 8am and 8pm. They will of course ring you sooner if anything happens that you need to know about that causes concern.

Your pet will always stay on our premises overnight. We do NOT move them to a different external out of hours provider.
